Äijävesi boat pier, end of Vihta-Paavontie Road, Rautalampi municipality centre

Rautalampi is an old mother parish and renowned for its numerous manors. Dig into the history of the manors in Rautalampi Museum, founded in 1938 by the mistress of the Korhola Manor and commercial counsellor Ms. Aina Peura. Opposite to the museum, on the other side of the village road, the Rautalampi Church, built in 1844, stands tall. It is one of the largest wooden churches in Finland. You can book guided tours to the Church Park and to the village itself.

The paddling route starts from the Rautalampi municipality centre at the pier in end of the Vihta-Paavontie Road. There is also a parking lot there. The best place to start the paddling trip is the natural beach, because the boat pier is guite high from the water. The use of the Äijävesi paddling harbour close by has been discontinued.

The best view of the manors opens from the lake. The Sahala and

The Korhola and Sahala Manor milieus, Rautalampi Museum, Rautalampi Church

Route markings: route has not been marked on the terrain.

Korhola Manors are open for tourists. You can see the Karjala Manor well from the lake, but that manor is in private use and it is not allowed to go ashore on the manor's land. The recommended place to go ashore and have a break can be found at the Korhola Manor. Accommodation and catering services are available for those who announce their arrival beforehand. There is also a chance to see the artwork of Ms. Oili Marski.

A little further from the Korhola Manor lays the place which gave name to the parish, municipality and village of Rautalampi. The place is a lake with the same name, which comes from the ironrich rust-coloured water.

You can also go to see the Sahala Manor, but there is no decent place to go ashore. In the vicinity of the Manor there is the Salli saddle chair factory, and during summer months, the Mansion of Experience and Friendship provides accommodation in granaries with porridge breakfast.
