

LOUKKUVUORI HIKING TRAIL, 2.8 km CIRCULAR ROUTE

Starting point:

Enonranta. You can get to Enonranta via Lake Konnevesi by boat or a canoe/kayak. You can also take a bicycle and cycle on the Loukkuvuori road to get to the trail. The road is closed with gates for automobile traffic.

Difficulty:

challenging, large elevation variations, rocky terrain

Duration:

2 hours

Places & things to see:

Loukkuvuori vantage point at the top of the National Park.

Trail markings:

yellow paint

Facilities:

There's a landing stage and a canoe step in Enonranta, and also a lean-to/hut and an outdoor toilet. Please bring your own toilet paper.

Preferred travelling direction:

counter-clockwise

The Loukkuvuori Trail offers a good hike for boaters and paddlers to stretch their "lake legs". The trail takes you up to the top of Loukkuvuori Mountain and back to the beach. A great vista over the Lake Konnevesi opens up at the top of the mountain. The trail goes up and down, and is rocky in some sections. In Enonranta, there is a landing stage and a canoe step, a lean-to/hut and an outdoor toilet.

The Majaniemi Registered Association is renting the old idyllic fishing hut which is located in the southern tip of Cape Majaniemi. Majaniemi is an ideal place for paddlers and backpackers who wish to stay overnight in the National Park. (http://majaniemi.org)
