A Sahala Manor

A significant large estate established at the end of the 18th Century with versatile business activities.

B Kaijärvi

Homestead of writer & poet Yrjö Kaijärvi (private estate)

- Toholahti Bridge

 Vantage point over the centuries- old cultural landscape.
- Upper Secondary School Plaza

 Buildings related to the old secondary school of the parish village.
- **E** Whipping Pine

Ancient place of punishment located at the municipality plaza.

- Museum Block

 Museum of Rautalampi, Outdoor Museum and Café Aurora.
- **Pitkänlahti Beach**Former church boat pier and beach.
- Community Hall & Hiring Road

 Centre Stage of old trade and worker culture.

- Central Village Road

 Nationally significant cultural environment of Rautalampi.
- Church of St. Nicholas (Orthodox church)
 The Church of St. Nicholas, built in 1959
 and designed by architect Ilmari Ahonen.
- Church of Rautalampi (Lutheran church)

 One of the largest wooden churches in Finland, built in 1844.
- M Äijävesi Beach
 The Äijävesi cultural landscape surrounded by the homes of the gentlefolk.
- Korhola Manor

A significant former grand estate. The main building is from 1868. Currently an atelier of the artist Oili Marski and in travel use.

P Konnekoski Rapid

The largest rapid in Rautalampi which has been the centre of many local manors since the 17th Century. Also a popular place for rapid fishing and white-water kayaking.

Q Törmälä

Currently working as a holiday and course centre and a gateway to the Southern Konnevesi National Park, Törmälä used to be a vicarage. It was established in the 17th Century.

R Hanhitaipale Harbour

The village of Hanhitaipale was established in the 17th Century, and the harbour along with it. The harbour still works as fishing and boating port..

S Kivisalmi

The Finnish War was waged in 1808 and 1809, and this place was one of the locations of guerrilla warfare. Currently, a beautiful scenic spot and vantage point. Here you can also find a plane crash memorial and services of the Kivisalmen Kievari Inn.
